Each Internal mentor was asked to engage 10 sessions during week days or weekends, depending on the convenience of the mentors and mentees. Dr..Bindu U, Assistant Professor of Chemistry and Ms.Sreeja Gopal, Assistant Professor of Economics attended the district wise Induction/Orientation programme for Internal Mentors held at Govt.Victoria College, Palakkad. The modules for mentoring provided by the State team were passed on to the Mentors.

#### **External Mentors:**

Each college was asked, by the State Co-ordinator WWS, to submit a list of External Mentors. People from various walks of life who have excelled in their respective areas were identified. The college submitted a list of 14 names, and all of them were incorporated in the District wise External Mentors list provided by the State Co-ordinator. External mentors from the Palakkad, Malappuram and Thrissur Lists were invited to hold sessions in the campus.

External Mentoring Sessions were started in January. The Inaugual Session was engaged by Dr.Sarin P IAAS, Former Dpty CAG. It was an extremely invigorating session on identifying one's target in life and working to achieve it. The speaker gave examples from his life, the road to Civil Service. The students were enthused after the session.

Inspite of a number of limitations, the WWS team of the college was able to organise fifty sessions on varied subjects in this academic year. Civil Services Orientation was a Major area and Eminent Civil Servants like Mr.Lipin Raj IRPS, Mr.Jyothis Mohan IRS et al addressed the mentees.

English language communication and achieving fluency in the language was another thrust area. For handling this topic Prof.Abdul Ali, Former HOD English, MES Kalladi College, Mannarkkad, Ms.Swapna Vinod, Communicative English Trainer and Mr. Abdul Latheef Naha, Correspondent, The Hindu were invited.

The students were given an idea about life skills and goal setting with the sessions handled by Ms.Anitha M.P, Freelance Counselor, Mr.Ashok Nemmara, Mr.C.K Suresh, Director ATMA(Attitude Training and management Associates) and theatre artist and Director Mr. M.U.Praveen.

Stress Managemnet was another are essential for teenagers. Mr.K Gopalan, Asst.Professor, HPK College of Teacher Education gave students tips to overcome stress, especially during exams.

The mentees got to know about the possibilities of new career paths like start ups and the basics of entrepreneurship in a session by Mr.Shahul Hameed, Product Engineer, entri.me.

But one of the most inspiring sessions held this year was the one by Mr. Ajay Balachandran. Even after being a quadriplegic Mr.Ajay came to the college to talk to the mentees and opened a new world of possibilities. He encouraged the mentees to overcome hurdles and work hard to achieve their goal.

#### **State Motivation Camp:**

The State Motivation Camp, Kozhikode Zone was held at University of Calicut Campus, Thenhippalam, Malappuram from 4<sup>th</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> of February 2019. Arpitha Unni,

II BSc Zoology was selected to represent the college in the camp. She was really happy to meet her counterparts from various other colleges. Being a civil services aspirant, this was an opportunity for Arpitha to interact with eminent personalities and also hone her skills.

#### **Mock Test/GD/Interview:**

A team from CARE, an agency involved in recruitment and training was invited to conduct the mock test and GD for the second year mentees. An aptitude test modelled on Competitive exams was conducted. The mentees were then divided into groups and given topics of contemporary relevance to debate on. A personal interview was also conducted by the team. The students found the session extremely useful. They were also given tips for preparing their resume.

#### **Study Materials:**

Books for Competitive Exam preparation, general reading, improving language fluency, books on personality development etc. were purchased. The books are stocked in the College Central Library and are available exclusively to the WWS mentees. Separate Stock and Issue registers are maintained for this. Mentees were also given a Mathrubhumi English Yearbook 2019. Each mentee was also given basic stationery, a notebook and a pen.

#### **Evaluation of the Programme:**

The External mentoring sessions helped to sharpen various skills of the mentees. It also enabled them to fix a target and work hard to achieve it. The mentoring sessions aided the mentees to stay focussed and motivated them to dream big. The framing of time table for the programme was the greatest challenge faced by the internal mentors due to the tight scheduling of academic activities under semester system. Still, the internal mentors played their part well under these constraints and tried to complete the mentoring sessions on time.
